

Following dinner and the Dri-Design wall system presentation, the group then adjourned and reassembled across the complex at the Sheetz Corporate Training Center currently under construction. This facility was designed so that all offices have an outside wall in order

to bring the outside indoors. The materials chosen for the building are "of the landscape" utilizing warm brown tones and natural hues.

Designed by L. R. Kimball, the Center has 123,000 square feet and is being built



at a cost of \$28 million. The tour of the interior spaces was led by Mr. Gary LaPara, FAIA, lead architect on the project for Kimball. Mr. LaPara anticipates move in to occur in December 2017 / January 2018.



I remember the days of BOCA and all the different versions that were molded to fit different areas of our great Country. Then the ICC came along and streamlined the Codes to make one set applicable to anywhere in the country. On paper, this looked good. However, not taken into account, was giving the states the right to adopt whatever year version they so desired. Consequently, for those of us with Professional Registration in various states, we are now dealing with anywhere from the 2003 IBC version to the 2015 IBC version which change at 3 year intervals. Pennsylvania still uses the 2009 version. Next year, we will have the 2018 version to add to our libraries. I am not sure ICC nor many of us, expected this. I know I did not. Also, I am not sure we can do anything about it and will need to ride the waves. Double checking state websites will give you the answer to what version in which particular state is being enforced. If you do not have that version on your shelf, pdf's can be downloaded. Good luck in this additional bit of research!




